

## Instructions for Sewing Diapers

Cut 2 pieces of fabric using the pattern. (Please use soft flannel material. One may be printed, but one needs to be a solid matching color.)

Sew the two pieces of material together with the pretty side in (so it looks backward when you are sewing it.) Sew it to make about a ¼ inch seam. Leave about a 3 inch opening along the straight side at the back for turning.

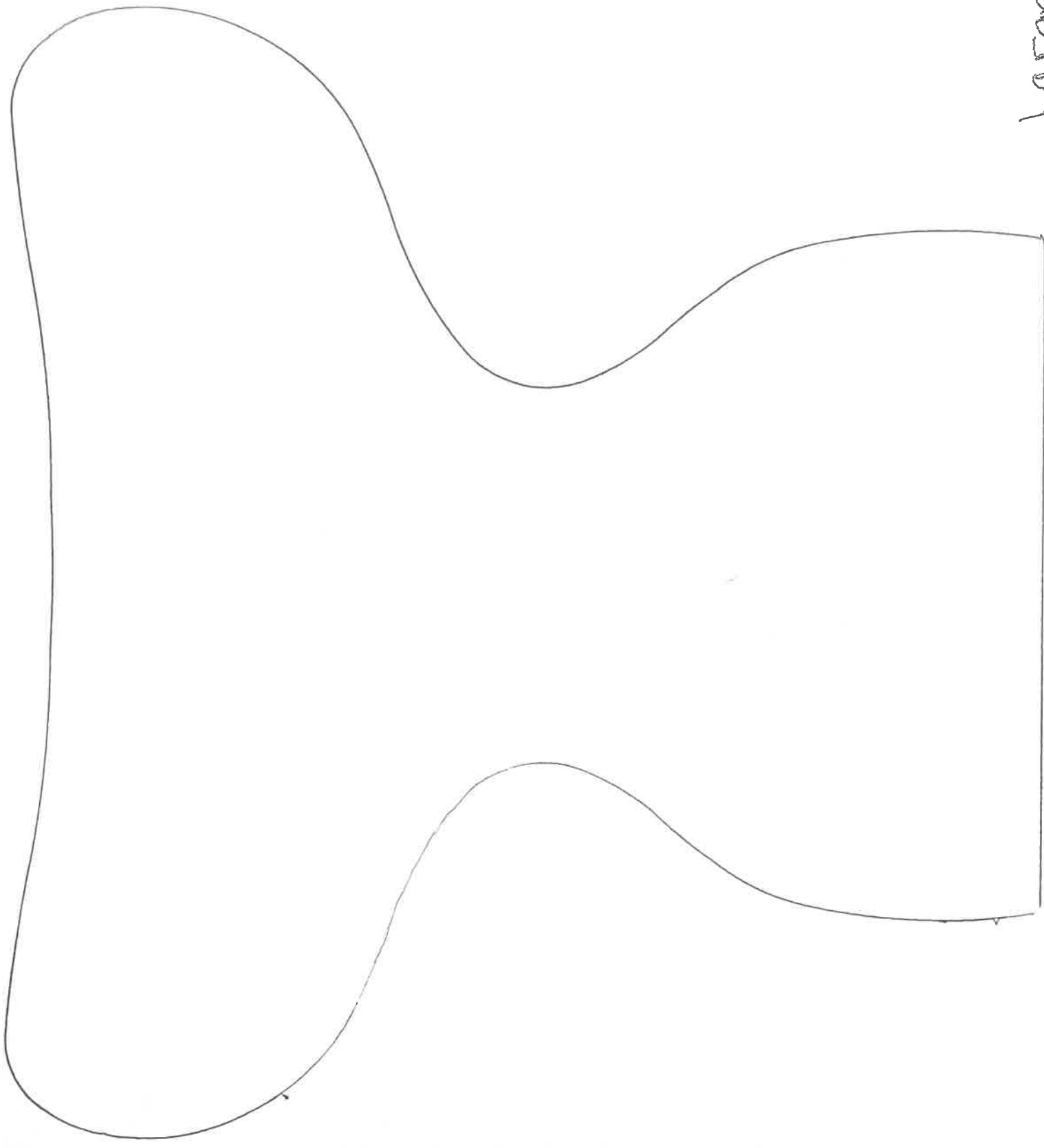
You may need to trim the corners and curved areas.

Next, turn the material through the opening you left. Then, tuck the raw edge of the opening in and topstitch the opening closed. Continue topstitching around the entire diaper. Finally, iron the diaper.

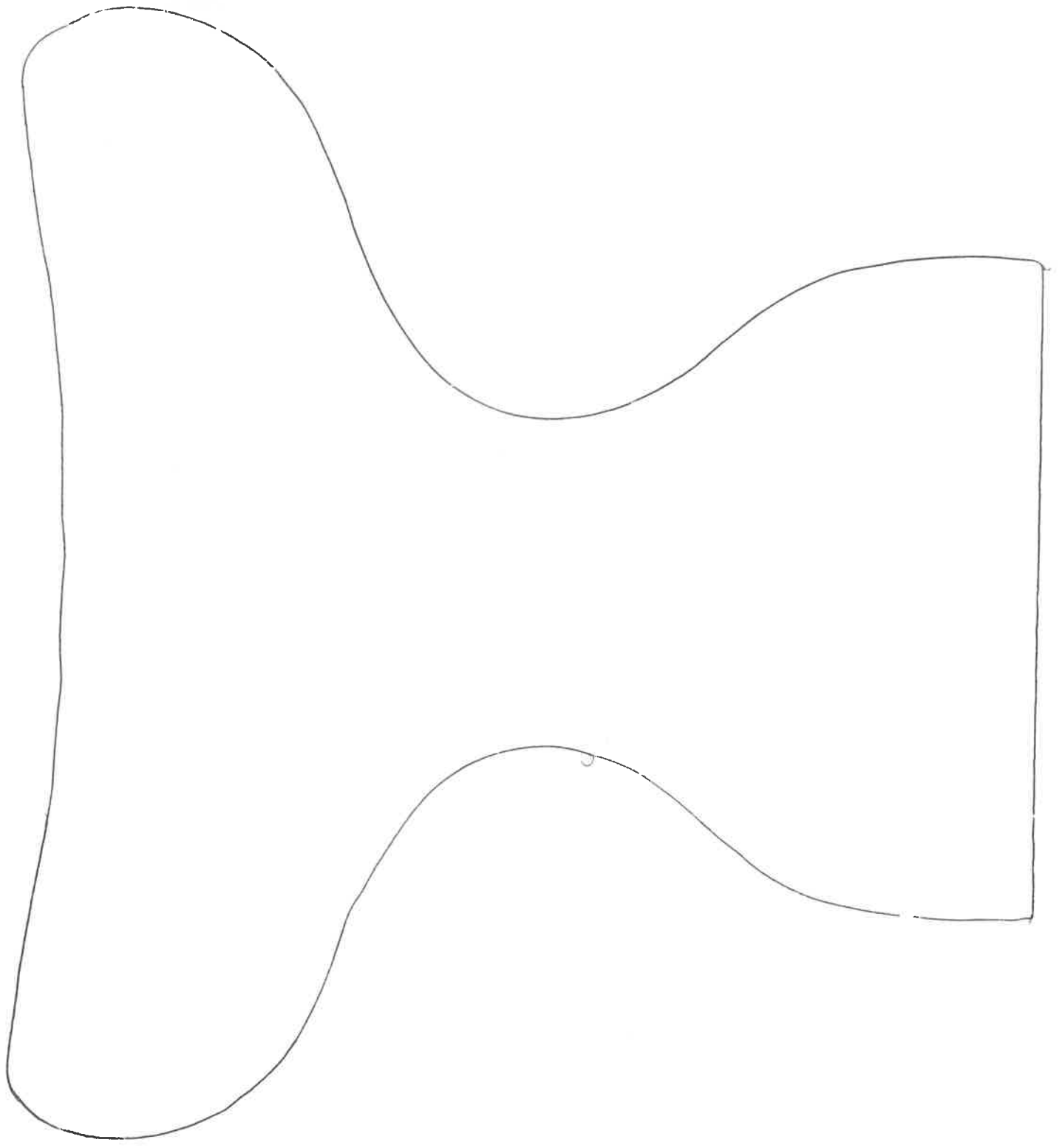
Congratulations, you are finished! Thank you for your help!

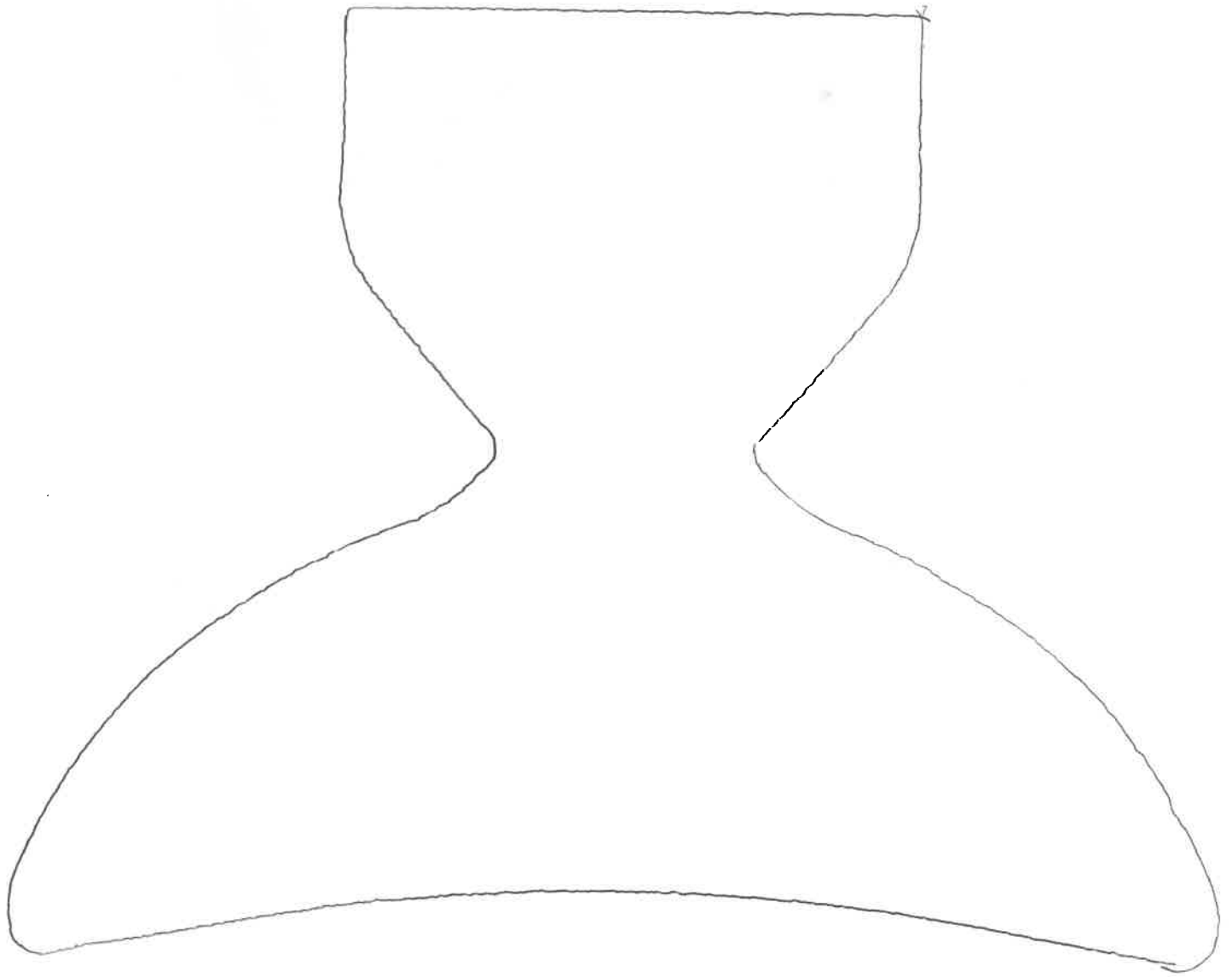
**\*\*Special Request:** When choosing your material, please do not pick dark or bright colors and try not to use any paw print patterned material. Thank you!
